### **Measure Z Bond Passes with Overwhelming Support**

On November 8, 2016, over 71% of the voters in the East Side Union High School District gave a vote of confidence in the East

Side Union High School District with the approval of Measure Z. Measure Z is a \$509,165,000 general obligation bond, which will provide funding to continue the improvements and rehabilitation of comprehensive high schools and alternative, adult, and District charter schools.

The new Hooper Hall will feature an expanded food service area and space for student activities in an open, inviting environment. The expansion of the food service area will allow for service to more students simultaneously. The quad areas adjacent to Hooper Hall will also be renovated, including new outdoor furnishings and potential path changes for better student flow and interaction.**

**Construction on Swimming Pools at James Lick, Mt. Pleasant, Silver Creek and Santa Teresa Nearing Completion; Schools are Expected to Use Pools in late January**

The wait for the modernized pools set to enhance the aquatic programs at seven high schools, is almost over. The new pools will feature a peninsula walkway, which will separate the deep water area, to be used by competition programs, from the shallow area, to be used for physical education, shallow water swim practice and recreational swim programs. The pools will meet current high school competition pool dimensions for competition swimming, water polo and diving.

All pool equipment will be replaced with energy efficient water circulation pumps /motors, improved water filtration and disinfection systems. New surge tanks will save pool water

displaced by swimmers. New LED underwater lighting will provide for improved visibility, improved energy efficiency and reduced maintenance. New pool decks will have deck drainage, improved gutter systems and steel bar reinforcement to eliminate deck cracks. The decks will meet current ADA code requirements and have a new ADA accessible outdoor shower for all pool users. New fencing with privacy fence screening will be installed.

"The new pool will be a huge upgrade from the old one. The students have already started talking about it and they can't wait to get in. Having a state of the art pool will also help us host swim meets. It will also look more inviting for students who are on the edge about joining the Water Polo or Swim Team. I'm excited about the new pool and can't wait to see how it'll look."
