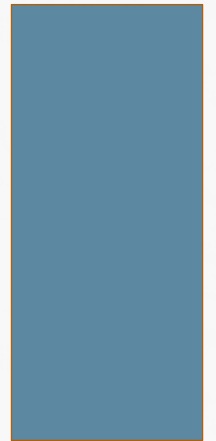


OVERVIEW OF BOND FUNDING FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS

BOND FUNDING FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS

- Under Proposition 39, Charter Schools are eligible for the District's Bond Measure proceeds. The Bond funds may only be used to improve District buildings and properties and/or to provide appropriate equipment. The Board of Trustees approves a Prioritization List for each Bond Measure and allocates an amount to Alternative Education using that bond measure's Equity Distribution Methodology.
 - Measure G: \$10,036,181
 - Measure E: \$27,460,000
 - Measure I: \$5,112,750
- Charter School Facilities Management Responsibilities
 - Assistance with Proposition 39 charter school facilities petitions
 - Proposed planning, design and construction of charter school facility improvements
 - Liaison for repairs, maintenance, and modification of charter school facilities
 - Annual compliance inspections

PROCESS FOR CHARTER SCHOOLS

- Charters and District programs categorized as Alternative Education are allocated bond funding through the Equity Distribution Methodology
- District creates a facilities use agreement that identifies the facilities that will be used by a charter. In some cases, these facilities may need to be improved on to create an individual campus environment within an existing campus
- District uses the bond allocation for Alternative Education to fund the improvements

PROJECT EXAMPLES

- Refurbishment of existing classroom space and office space, including construction and installation of furniture
- New Restroom buildings
- Modifications to clock/bell/paging
- Technology and computer equipment
- Improvements and reconfiguration of existing portable classroom buildings to form an individual campus environment for charter school occupants

CURRENT PROJECTS

Yerba Buena

- Demolition and removal of existing portable classrooms for additional program growth. Installation of new and reconfiguration of existing portable classrooms at LVLA

Independence

- Modernization of Building J to house Pegasus High School.
- Minor and major modernization work in Building L to house Downtown College Prep charter school was completed. DCP moved into Building L in August 2016
- Minor and major modernization work in Buildings G & H to house ACE Charter School
